Gas TSOs of the North West Region publish the 4th edition of their Gas Regional Investment Plan

(Brussels, 23 June 2020, PR0210-20) The TSOs of the North West Region are pleased to announce the publication of the fourth edition of their Gas Regional Investment Plan (NW GRIP).

The GRIPs are prepared to promote regional cooperation as enshrined in EU Directive 2009/73/EC (Article 7), and further detailed by Article 12 of Regulation 715/2009. The aim of the NW GRIP is to supplement ENTSOG's EU-wide Ten-Year Network Development Plan 2018 (TYNDP 2018) by providing additional information, specifically on the North West Region.

The report covers the two topics of main interest in the North West Region - it gives an insight into the ongoing energy transition by listing some of the initiatives TSOs are involved in and secondly, the report zooms in on the L-gas developments and the related infrastructure conversion needs.

The NW GRIP is the result of close cooperation between the TSOs from 10 countries of the North West Region, under the coordination of Fluxys and GTS.

The NW Region's TSOs hope that this report will provide useful information to all stakeholders and would welcome any comments or feedback that could assist in improving the future editions of this report.
