

History of data publication





Publication on GTS-web-site

- GTS started publication of numerical data before Regulation 715/2009
 - Definition and format of data-items defined by GTS
- Transparency requirements from Dutch Transmission conditions agreed with NRA
- Requirements from regulation 715/2009
 - Strong overlap with national requirements
 - Slightly different definition of some data-items



Consequences of introduction ENTSOG TP

- Added value of a central European platform ENTSOG-TP
 - One-stop shop for transmission data in the EU
 - Uniform data-formats
 - API to retreive data
- Publication on GTS-website and ENTSOG-TP
 - Most information published twice
 - Definition of specific data-items differed between the platforms
 - Questions on perceived inconsistencies
 - Operational and maintenance effort on two data channels
- GTS decided to reduce transparency publication on its website



Reducing transparency publication on GTS-website

- Data was published both on ENTSOG-TP and GTS-website
- No concernes raised by user of GTS-website
 - Data still available
 - Link to ENTSOG-TP
- Reduce complexity and costs for GTS
 - Gradually removed reports from GTS-website
 - Publishing link to ENTSOG-TP on GTS-website
 - Specific Dutch requirements continued at GTS-website
 - In line with transparency guideline annexed to Reg. 715/2009
- Currently only
 - Interruption data
 - Information on transfer of capacity
